NUCLEAR ENGINEERING STUDENT ADVOCACY AND AWARENESS COMPETITION

ANS Student Sections around the country will be asked to coordinate and film an activity on their campuses during the week of **Nuclear Science Week (NSW), October 17 - 21, 2016**. The student sections will then be asked to upload their videos (3-5 minutes in length) to social media and/or video sharing platforms of their choice, send the videos to ANS and YMG, and compile a brief report detailing their activity/campaign as well as the social media impact.

A panel of judges drawn from ANS, NAYGN, and elsewhere in the nuclear industry will then judge the activities based on creativity, professionalism, messaging, and social media impact.

A first, second, and third place prize, of **\$500, \$250, and \$150**, respectively, will be awarded based on the judging.

Videos and reports will need to be submitted by October 31, 2016 and the winners will be announced at or before the ANS Winter Meeting, November 6-10, 2016.
