- Nuclear Matters has launched a pilot effort to create an Ambassador program for advocacy efforts – called the Nuclear Energy Ambassador Program.
- Initial pilot training program with Columbia Generating Station.

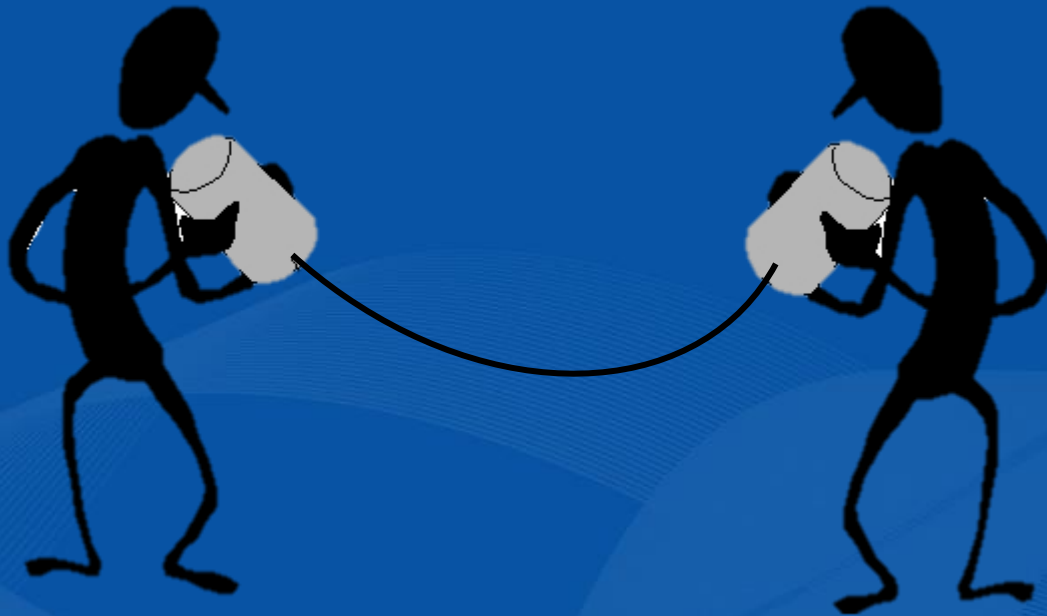

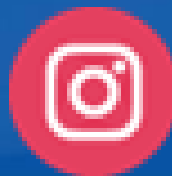
