1. Go to NAYGN.ORG

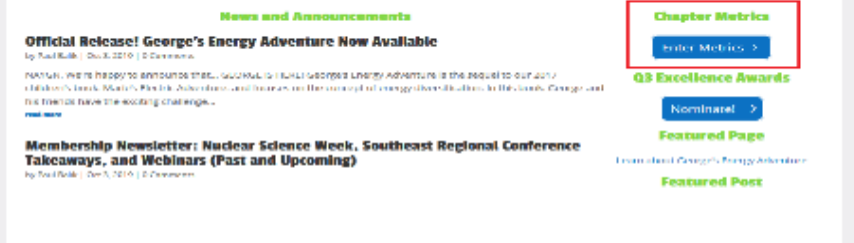

- ▶ ~75% of the NAYGN budget goes to professional development opportunities for its members

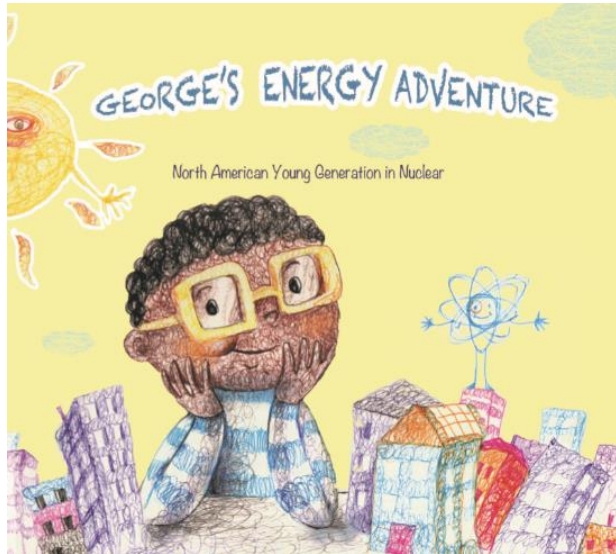

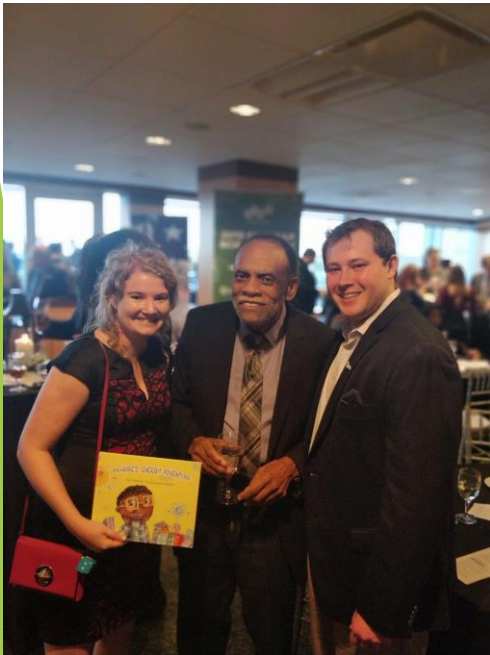
Benchmarking Update

Midwest Regional Conference

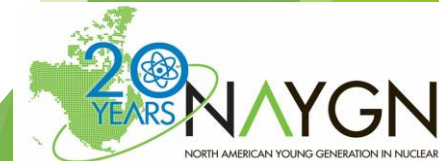
- ▶ Midwest Regional Conference
