

CONTINENTAL SENSEI AWARDS

WHAT ARE THE SENSEI AWARDS?

SENSEI stands for Seasoned Employee/Non-Seasoned Employee Interface. The Award is designed to reward mentors who have gone above and beyond to help younger employees succeed. As Knowledge Transfer and Retention (KT&R) continues to be a focus for NAYGN, the SENSEI Awards are a way to formally recognize existing examples of KT&R throughout the industry.

HOW ARE AWARD WINNERS SELECTED?

A total of 16 Continental SENSEI Award winners will be selected by an NAYGN committee. Good candidates for the award are those who have worked directly with an NAYGN member and gone beyond their typically job duties to help their mentee learn and become better at his or her job.

ARE THERE PRIZES?

Yes! Continental SENSEI Award winners will receive an embroidered polo shirt and award to commemorate their success as a mentor. Nominators will also receive an NAYGN polo.

HOW DO I NOMINATE SOMEONE?

To nominate someone from a Continental SENSEI Award, simply complete and submit an [award application](#) through the NAYGN website. Nominations will be accepted from May 1 to June 30 and winners will be announced in the Fall.

One SENSEI candidate can be nominated by up to two NAYGN nominators. Nomination forms ask for basic information about the nominee and nominator(s) as well as a brief explanation about why the nominee should be selected for the award.
