Nominations for the Hub Steering Committee

Background

At the 2014 NAYGN Annual Conference, NAYGN members voted to select *the Hub* from Entergy's River Bend Chapter as the winner of NAYGN's inaugural innovation competition. *The Hub* is an industry-wide, knowledge-transfer platform that combines the power of YouTube, Facebook, and Twitter with information from nuclear industry databases into one central Hub of knowledge.

NAYGN member Shonique Miller proposed *the Hub* to Nuclear Strategic Issues Advisory Committee (NSIAC) on December 11th. NSIAC endorsed the formation of an industry-wide task force to develop a full proposal and budget for future implementation of *the Hub*. Oversight of the task force will be through a 10-member steering committee. A letter is in preparation to all industry chief nuclear officers (CNOs) to request volunteers for *the Hub* task force and to solicit nominations for members of *the Hub* steering committee. The NAYGN chapter lead (or their designee) will serve as the point of contact to identify and nominate candidates for the steering committee. The steering committee will present *the Hub* proposal to NSIAC as an industry initiative by year-end.

The Hub is a first-of-a-kind opportunity for NAYGN to implement a new and innovative approach to industry-wide knowledge transfer for young professionals. NAYGN seeks leaders passionate about knowledge transfer to develop and deliver the Hub.

Actions

Chapter Leads identify and nominate volunteers with the following backgrounds to fill key leadership positions on *the Hub* 10-member steering committee:

- <u>Training</u> Accredited and Non-Accredited Training Experience
- Communications Graphics, Transmedia and Videography Experience
- Information Technology Web Design and Software Development Experience
- <u>Change Management</u> Experience with Knowledge Transfer and Organizational Effectiveness
- Finance Proposal Writing and Budget Development Experience
- Project Execution Experience Leading Multi-Company and Remote Teams

Submit the enclosed nomination form (or equivalent) by <u>Monday, February 16</u> to <u>thehub@naygn.org</u>. Nominees for the steering committee need <u>not</u> be NAYGN members. It is expected that the steering committee members will dedicate up to 5-10 hours per week. Each company will have to decide if this time is during or after work hours.

Steering committee members will be notified by the second week in March for a kick-off meeting. A wider solicitation will be sent to all NAYGN local chapters for volunteers for the associated task force(s) after formation of the steering committee.
