

Every year we ask our organization and chapters across North America to track metrics against Professional Development, Networking, Public Information, and Community Service to measure the incredible impact we make on the industry, each other, and our communities. In 2023, NAYGN made a significant impact on the future leaders of the nuclear industry and our communities - check out our impact:



What made a difference in metrics for 2023?

We made significant progress from 2022 Metric Hours:

- 42% Increase in Professional Development Hours
- 243% Increase in Networking Hours
- 54% Increase in Community Service Hours
